### GREAT GARDEN ADVENTURE PROGRAM COORDINATOR

# **Role Description:**

The Great Garden Adventure (GGA) Program Coordinator will assist in the development and implementation of variety of children's gardening programs. The successful applicant must be 15-30 years old and a full time student returning to school in the fall. They will be responsible for facilitating gardening activities for children, organizing program supplies, instructing and supervising program participants and staff volunteers, and ensuring the safety and enjoyment of all program participants. This position may also include some program networking and outreach with other Toronto organizations in an effort to develop new partnerships for Toronto Green Community (TGC) 'Greening Toronto Gardens' work.

The GGA Coordinator will work both in the TGC office at Yonge and Eglinton, and on site in 3-5 different garden locations around the city for 8 weeks throughout the summer.

## **Responsibilities:**

- Coordinate and deliver the 'Great Garden Adventure' Children's gardening program (planning garden-focused crafts and physical activities, explaining ideas of composting and sustainable gardening to children 10 and under, running GGA garden activities)
- Liaise with existing community partners
- Research additional communities to deliver the program to
- Manage material requirements for program budget and track attendance
- Outreach to media and the community about the program
- Collaborate with Garden Coordinator on other garden activities as needed
- Report to the ED on Great Garden Adventure activities
- Assist with fundraising activities as needed
- Complete evaluations with community partners

- Strong environmental background
- Experience with working with children/youth (Teaching experience an asset)
- Passionate about environmental education
- Arts and crafts skills an asset
- Ability to identify plants, basic gardening knowledge
- Ability to coordinate groups and publicize events effectively
- Attending College or University and returning in the Fall
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Excellent organizational, planning and time management skills
- Able to work independently and as a team member
- Positive attitude and good sense of humour
- Provide a satisfactory Vulnerable Sector Security Check conducted by Toronto Police
